ID-AYU0182) with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 51 seats in 08 PG Courses in the subjects namely : - (i) Shalya Tantra- 12 seats, (ii) Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan - 04 seats, (iii) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisjya Kalpana- 05 seats, (iv) Prasuti Tantra & Stri Roga- 06 seats, (v) Kaumarbhritya - 06 seats, (vi) Shalakya Tantra - 06 seats(Ent-03 seats and Eye-03 seats), (vii) Kayachikitsa- 06 seats, (viii) Panchkarma- 06 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2026-27-reg.

Sir/Madam,

- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely to Late Kedari Redekar Ayurvedic Mahavidyalaya, Gadhinglaj, Kohlapur, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0182) inspection was conducted on 01.06.2026 and 02.06.2026 on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the permission with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 51 seats in 08 PG Courses in the subjects namely : - (i) Shalya Tantra- 12 seats, (ii) Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan - 04 seats, (iii) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisjya Kalpana- 05 seats, (iv) Prasuti Tantra & Stri Roga- 06 seats, (v) Kaumarbhritya - 06 seats, (vi) Shalakya Tantra - 06 seats(Ent-03 seats and Eye-03 seats), (vii) Kayachikitsa- 06 seats, (viii) Panchkarma- 06 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2026-27.
- 2) The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations thereunder and On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcomings/defects have been observed:-

1. Aadhaar Enabled Biometric attendance System

- a) Out of 82 teaching faculty members, it is submitted that, on verification of AEBAS data from 01.06.2025 to the date of visitation, it has been observed that below mentioned faculties are not having attendance as per the requirement:-

2. Functionality of the hospital:- Average bed occupancy percentage is 59.05 %.

- 3) Accordingly, the assessment report was duly placed in the 168th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 05.08.2026 and Board concluded that the college is fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations but fulfilling the criteria for issuance of Extended. Hence, the Board decided to issue extended permission in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 51 seats in 08 PG Courses under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2026-27 as the college has been permitted consecutively for previous three years after fulfilling the conditions as specified in the concerned Regulations but with the condition to fulfill the above mentioned shortcomings as soon as possible.

"DECISION"

- 4) **Therefore, Extended permission is hereby granted to Late Kedari Redekar Ayurvedic Mahavidyalaya, Gadhinglaj, Kohlapur, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0182) in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 51 seats in 08 PG Courses under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2026-27 subject to the condition that the the aforementioned shortcomings shall be fulfilled along with the following conditions:-**
- I. **Minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 51 seats in 08 PG Courses** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2026-27 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
- 5) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 6) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 7) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 8) **Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. Ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.**
- 9) **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2026 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2027-2028:-**
- All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled,
 - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024,
 - All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
 - The shortcomings mentioned in Para No. 2 shall be fulfilled within 3 months.
- 10) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2027-2028.
